Nationally-recognized enrichment program for young children comes to the Pittsburgh Area

Imagine Tomorrow® classes are now being offered

During class, children become Computer Detectives on a learning adventure to imaginative places such as the Email Trail or Internet Island. Classes start with an interactive video voicemail describing a new, fun-filled mission. Children then move on to their own computers where they work on custom software designed specifically for each mission. Advancing at their own pace, children proudly apply new technology skills to solve problems and accomplish their goals. Concepts such as e-mail, opening and closing programs, and how the computer works are presented in a fun, interactive way that also incorporates mouse and keyboarding skills. The children regroup at the end of class to review what they've learned in the lesson. After class, children continue to enjoy their mission from home with online software activities that correspond to the current lesson.

"This is a truly immersive learning experience for young children", states Beth Ezar, owner of Wee Teach U. "When my 4-year-old son took his first Imagine Tomorrow® class, he was completely engrossed and he couldn't stop smiling. He was so proud of himself for his accomplishments", she continues.
